About CEN

The Climate Educator Network CEN is a web based community platform that enables educators all over the world to motivate their students, volunteer groups and colleagues to become active for a sustainable future. CEN aims to facilitate know-how exchange amongst educators, to support online collaboration, and to connect ideas in order to inspire new ways of thinking in project work.

In a society coping with complex global challenges such as climate change and a shortage of resources, education needs to become more than knowledge transfer.

To build a sustainable society, capacities such as being able to think in connections, change perspectives, develop visions for the future, discover possibilities to contribute and make a change, or to find and realize solutions together need to be trained.

How CEN works
